The tour will continue to nearby Woodinville, Washington State's oldest and most acclaimed winery, Chateau Ste. Michelle and a tasting experience second to none. Winemaker Bob Bertheau crafts Washington wines that are expressions of the best vineyards in the state. Known for its highly-acclaimed Chardonnay, Riesling, Merlot and Cabernet, Chateau Ste. Michelle receives some of the highest accolades every year.



Next, guests will travel to nearby Columbia Winery. Columbia Winery is the ideal location for a relaxed wine tasting. The winery is a landmark Victorian mansion surrounded by a picture perfect English garden. Located at the side bar in the tasting room, guests will be able to taste five different wines showcasing the range of talents and tastes at this stunning winery. Then it's back to the Fairmont Hotel in time for a fine Seattle dining experience.
